...from the East Mesa York Rite

WAS KING SOLOMON A YORK RITE MASON? You decide.

The Grand Master of Masons is addressed as Most Worshipful Grand Master. The Masters of our Lodges are addressed as Worshipful. Chapters of Royal Arch Masons in the York Rite are lead in the East by a High Priest who is addressed as Excellent High Priest. And, in the case of the Grand Chapter, he is addressed as Most Excellent Grand High Priest. In our degrees in the Blue Lodge, two of our founding Grand Masters are referred to as Grand Master Hiram Abiff or Grand Master Hiram, King of Tyre. However, you will, no doubt, remember that Solomon, King of Israel is repeatedly referred to as "Most Excellent King Solomon". It seems to me that the writers of our ritual believed that Solomon was a Royal Arch Mason by virtue of his title.

(Note: this idea was originally developed by Most Worshipful Brother Dr. J.C. Montgomery Jr., Past Grand Master of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons in Missouri.)
