It makes us all very happy to have new girls that are interested in Job's Daughters!

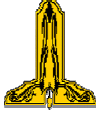

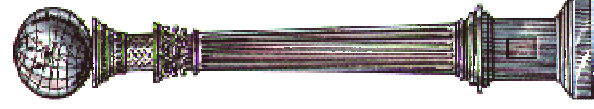
