Bethel No.13 meets on the 1st and 3rd Fridays starting at 7pm.

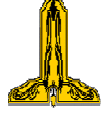
Our first meeting is February 3rd which is usually a stop and go meeting so we can achieve good ritual and floor work.

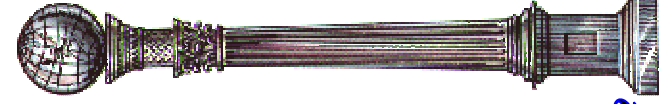
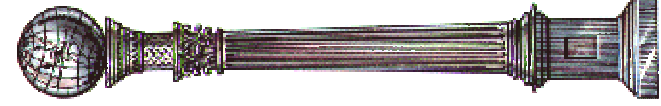
