We will be attending Grand Lodge this month. It will be June 6th, 7th and 8th in Lake Havasu City.

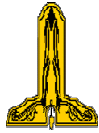

He is responsible for introducing and accommodating all visitors. He, and the Junior Deacon, should insure that all visitors are welcomed and made to feel at home in our Lodge. In conjunction with the Tyler, he must make sure that the visitor is a Regular Mason in Good Standing before they are admitted to the Lodge and that the Tyler's Oath is administered by a committee to the visiting Brethren.

During this process, the Senior Deacon should learn the full name, home lodge and any honors that are due to the visitor for later introduction to our Worshipful Master in front of the assembled Brethren. To do this properly, the Senior Deacon must become familiar with the Titles of the various Masonic offices at Local and Grand Lodge levels and also the Masonic Protocols for these introductions.

His confidence in the performance of these duties reflects on our Lodge's reputation throughout the Masonic world.

He also receives and conducts the candidates for the various degrees. As their conductor, his knowledge and confidence in the performance of his duties can significantly enhance the candidate's degree experience.

Though there is great import in the diligent performance of his duties, the Senior Deacon's office can be a lot of fun and one of the most rewarding experiences for any Master Mason.

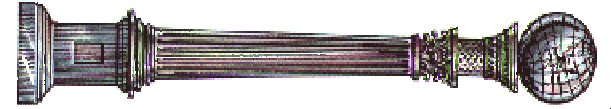
