Oh, and please remember to put our flag out on Memorial Day on the 28th!

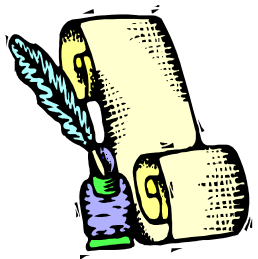
A final note... mark your calendars for Saturday, June 14th of June for our installation when we will crown our new Honored Queen.

Please come join us to see what we do at our May meetings on the 4th and the 18th at 7:00pm.

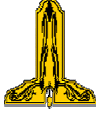

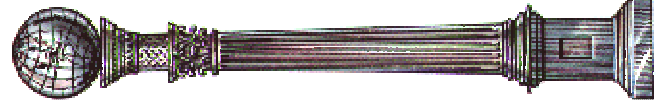
